We are pleased to announce that in January 2019 we will be launching 1000 Books Before Kindergarten at the Clifton Springs Library. 1000 Books Before Kindergarten is a free program that encourages parents and caregivers to share 1000 books with their little ones before Kindergarten. This early literacy initiative not only lays the foundation for a lifelong love of reading, it promotes family bonding.

Participation is easy! Simply register your child at the library, pick up a log sheet, and start reading. Every time you hit 100 books, bring the log sheet back to the library for a prize. While 1000 books may sound like a lot, if you read just 1 book a night, you'll log 365 books in one year! That's 730 books in two years and 1,095 books in three years! Children can join the program anytime between birth and their first day of Kindergarten.


MAKE A DIFFERENCE...
